


"'Sir,' the man replied, 'leave it alone for one more year, and I'll dig around it and fertilize it.'" What else did he say?

Start at the center, then follow the arrows to fill in the blanks.





There were some people with Jesus who questioned whether a group of Galileans suffered severely because they were wicked.


